### **Instructions for Oral and Poster Presentations**

**Oral Presentations:** A PC running Windows will be available for uploading presentations. If speakers wish to use their own PC or Mac then please test this ahead of your session. A member of the local organising committee will be available to assist in uploading and testing your presentation.

Keynote and Invited Talks are limited to 20 minutes with 10 minutes of discussion.

Abstract Talks are limited to 10 minutes plus 5 minutes of discussion.

We have a busy program and all speakers are kindly requested to stay within their time slot.

**Please note that we move from British Summer Time (BST) to Greenwich Mean Time (GMT) during the conference so clocks will go back one hour at 1am on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> October 2012.**

**Poster Presentations:** Please prepare posters in Portrait A0 format 841mm (width) x 1200mm (height).

All posters will be displayed from Saturday morning through to Sunday afternoon in the North Cloisters and Old Refectory. Dedicated poster viewing sessions are scheduled for Saturday afternoon (3-5pm) for EVEN numbered posters, and Sunday morning (9:30-11:30am) for ODD numbered posters. Refer to the "List of Posters" download on the program section of this website to check the number of your poster, and ensure that you are standing by your poster during the appropriate session.
